The picture comes with annotation that can be saved. It can support image freezing, rotation, zoom-in, zoom-out It supports full-screen recording. It supports for OCR recognition.

#### > 5.1.1. Snap

The icon:

**Operation**: When you click on the inverted triangle next to the snap , the screen will pop up the following function selections:



Default: Video previewed by the camera, shown as:



**Screen capture**: The entire software interface, Shown as:



■ Partial screen capture: You can zoom in and zoom out the selected area that you want, and then click on the icon icon to capture. Shown as:



**Timing capture**: When you click on the icon **o**, the screen will pop up the interval time and capture pages. Please set them and then click on the icon **o** to finish. Shown as:



Screen capture to clipboard: You can copy all on the screen and then paste them directly to your document instead of presenting them on the left gallery. Shown as:



- Black white capture: Captured color images by camera can be converted to black and white images.
- Gray capture: Captured color images by camera can be converted to gray images.

## 5.1.2. Video-Recording

The icon:

**Operation:** When you click on the icon , the screen will pop up the

following picture. You can choose the resolution you want.



Clicking on the icon **b** to start video-recording.



Clicking on the icon m to pause the video-recording. Clicking on the icon **m** to stop the video-recording and saving it in the default path.



## 5.1.3. OCR

The icon: OCR

**Operation:** Please select one picture on the left gallery, and then chick on the icon **OCR**, the screen will pop up the following picture:



Please select the detail language identification and import file, and then click on the icon **OCR Recognizing** and save it.

**Note:** To select the language identification is to improve the OCR recognition and the accuracy of documents.

Import File : You can select the document that needs to be identified by OCR from the computer folder.
